Our class is conducted using the TPRS method (Teaching Proficiency through Reading and Storytelling). Students are exposed to the through stories language and authentic situations. They are first introduced to new language, and then experience it in an interactive story. The method is very engaging and students actively participate by responding to events and answering questions. The focus of the method is developing fluency and understanding, along communication skills.
